- The Gospel of the Kingdom is what the Bible says Jesus preached. **Mark 1:14**
- The Kingdom was initiated when Christ came into the world. **Matthew 9:35-38**
- The Kingdom of God is the rule of God. **Psalm 103:19, Luke 17:20**
- The Kingdom of God is invisible. **Luke 17:20-21**
- The Kingdom of God does not originate from earth. **John 18:36**
- The Kingdom of God means that we become citizens and children through belief and repentance. **Matthew 4:17, John 3:3**
- The Kingdom of God becomes a reality in our life when we desire it, give it priority in our lives and invite it in.
Matthew 6:10, Matthew 6:33 (NKJV, AMP), Mark 12:30-31
- The Kingdom of God is supernatural. **John 3:5-6, Colossians 1:13**
- The Kingdom of God is a Kingdom of light. **1 John 1:5-9, John 8:12**
- The Kingdom of God is internal. **Romans 4:17**
- The Kingdom of God will one day be external and internal. **Revelation 11:15**
- The Kingdom of God has surpassing value. **Matthew 13:44-46**

Lessons of the Kingdom

- ❖ The Kingdom is bigger than any one person.
- ❖ The Kingdom of God is not dependent upon anyone on earth.
- ❖ There is only one Kingdom that counts. We are to be builders of the Kingdom of God, not our own little kingdoms.
- ❖ Our job is to conform to the Kingdom, not the other way around. **Romans 12:1-2**
We are children and subjects of the King.

God's Original Plan for Mankind

- To establish a family of Spiritual sons and daughters, not servants **John 1:12-13**
- To establish a Kingdom, not a religious organization
- To establish a Kingdom of kings not subjects **2 Peter 2:9, Rev. 1:6**
- To establish a Commonwealth of citizens, not religious members

- To establish a relationship with mankind, not a religion
- To extend His heavenly government to earth; and to influence earth from heaven through mankind
