Text: Psalm 72:17-19

The blessings God brings will affect people and **nations**. He is tender enough to know us by name and big enough to make His name great in a country. The whole earth is filled with His **glory**. Look around, His name is great. **Psalm 145:3**

Our trust in God causes our hearts to **rejoice**. It is a deep inward joy that radiates from our soul. This joy is seen in our countenance. **Psalm 33:21** There is a direct correlation between our joy and our trust in God. That is why we must know His name. Trusting in His name has an impact on our thinking and on our inner man.

- He Is our **Peace** - Jehovah-Shalom - the Lord is Peace. **Judges 6:24**
2 Thessalonians 3:16 - *Now may the Lord of Peace Himself give you peace at **all** times and in every way. The Lord be with you all.*

Shalom means whole, finished, perfected, favor, health, prosperity, rest and safety. It is related to the **welfare** of a person. Shalom is the kind of peace that results from being a **whole** person in right relationship with God and one's fellow man; peace with God, peace with self, peace with your **destiny** and peace in times of trouble. **Romans 16:20**

God's desire is that we live in peace, a peace that passes understanding, a peace that doesn't make **sense**. Our mind knows we should panic but His name sets our heart at rest. His peace will **guard** our heart.

Philippians 4:6-9, 1 Thess. 5:23, Hebrews 13:20-21

When the tough times come, begin by **praising** Him and His name. Thank Him for what He has done in the past, that will build faith for the present. We will worship Him for who He is. Praise is exaltation, acknowledgment, and a reminder.

~Saint Ignatius Loyola - *"In times of dryness and desolation we must be patient, and wait with resignation for the return of consolation, putting our trust in the goodness of God. We must energize ourselves by the thought that God is always with us, that He allows this trial, and that we haven't lost His grace because we have lost the taste and feeling of it."*

The peace of God will drive out all **fear** because it is administered in His love.

Judges 6:23-24 Gideon had a great deal to fear. It affected Him personally and the nation corporately. Because of the peace of God, he became a mighty man of valor. This is God's desire for all of us. If you are at peace you will put others at peace.

Without peace many ride the **roller coaster** of emotions. Shalom stops the ride.

1 Corinthians 15:57-58 We become steadfast and unmovable. **Proverbs 18:10**

- He Is the Refiner and purifier - He Is Jehovah M'Kaddesh or the Lord who sanctifies.
Malachi 3:2-3

He Is the God who cleans us up. God comes to remove whatever would tarnish and cheapen the treasure He has made us to be.

We are refined just like gold and silver. All the dross and all the impurities must be removed.

To sanctify means to be set apart for holiness. **1 Peter 3:15**

- He Is Jehovah- Tsidkenu or the Lord our righteousness. **Jeremiah 23:5-6**

He is the Lord of all that is right and is able to make us right. Jesus brings us into right standing with God. We could never do this because even our best righteousness is as filthy rags. **Romans 3:20**

He will clean us up and take us there as we obey Him. He will lead us in the paths of righteousness. **Psalm 23:3** It is God who helps us be declared innocent and stay that way.

Psalm 140:13

He takes away our guilt and shame. He executes true justice in our lives and in nations.

- He is our Shepherd - Jehovah- Rohi **John 10:11**

The Shepherd knows His sheep and they know Him and His voice. **John 10:14**

Because He is our Shepherd we will not lack. He will feed, He will guide, He will care for, He will protect.

He refreshes and He restores.

Because He is My Shepherd: - Psalm 23

 - I will not lack nourishment.
 - I will not lack rest.
 - I will not lack forgiveness and restoration.
 - I will not lack right relationship with God.
 - I will not lack encouragement and hope.
 - I will not lack a constant companion.

 - I will not lack power and authority.
 - I will not lack joy or abundant life.
 - I will not lack contentment.
