Text: Colossians 3:17

All that we do and say is to be done in the name of Jesus. We must remember that we represent Christ as heaven's ambassadors. This is a great privilege and a great responsibility not a burden. We must show His excellence through our actions, words and demeanor.

It is through His name that we can do all things well. From casting out demons to healing the sick, buttering the toast for our children or correcting people who are wrong. Do it all in Jesus' name. We are a people of excellence.

Everything we need is found in the Name of God. All that HE IS, is all that we need.

This lesson looks at words that describe what He IS not just what He does. The two are inseparable. Who HE IS - is what HE does.

- HE IS the Lord who heals. **Exodus 15:23-26**
That is His name. Jehovah-Rophe. HE IS the Great Physician. If we obey His word, He will heal and keep sickness from us.

Just like at the water of Marah, Jesus is the branch that heals the bitter waters of life. This healing covers every level of our living - physical, spiritual and emotional.

Psalms 103:1-5, Isaiah 53:4-5

God heals broken hearts and creates new beginnings. We must realize that this healing is part of His covenant. A covenant is only as good as the name it's based on. It is a promise to us and for us to use to bless the sick. We are to promote healing.

It is God's desire that you live both healed and healthy. Expect it, live it.

Notice the conditions for healing in **Exodus 15:26**.

listen carefully, do what is right, pay attention, keep all His decrees

Now let me ask you - is the Healer Your God or the sickness your god. Call on His Name.

- HE IS Jehovah-Jireh. That means to see ahead and provide. HE IS our Provider.
Genesis 22:4-14, Philippians 4:19

He sees our need before we do. Notice it says He shall supply all our need not needs.

He is all we need. Stop and think about that. Everything is adequately covered.

Even with faith, Abraham was tested right until the angel called to him at the last possible moment. God is rarely early, never late always right on time.

From the spot Abraham offered that sacrifice, God could see to Golgotha where Jesus met our greatest need. **2 Corinthians 9:8-10** From food and shelter to strength, wisdom and anointing He will provide all you need to abound.

➤ HE IS our Protector **Exodus 17:15, Song of Solomon 2:4**

Jehovah-Nissi - The Lord our Banner or the Lord is Conqueror our Defender- He is revealed this way during times of trouble, affliction or attack - spiritual or personal. Life is full of battles and problems. He desires us to understand that we are more than a conqueror. **Romans 8:35-37**

God intends for His people to win. If He IS your God then you are not a loser. Things may get difficult but He is your protection. He is God- stop your whining. In your battle, lift up your banner. A banner is a flag of identification, of which side that we are on. Let the enemy and everyone else know who you identify with. Declare your victory.

The battle is the Lord's, HE will bring the breakthrough. HE will cause us to triumph. Faith brings the victory. He is the God of the breakthrough and the barrier breaker.

The enemy will attack when you are tired, weak, sick or having one problem after another. With our Banner, we go from faith to faith, glory to glory, strength to strength. That also means we will encounter problems, challenges and resistance.

Romans 1:17, 2 Corinthians 3:18, Psalm 84:7, 1 John 5:4

Defeatism is a curse. Remember, in warfare the banner is placed right in the front.

In **Zechariah 2:5** He promises to be a Wall of Fire. He will keep the enemies from infiltrating. This wall does three things.

1. It separates. HE will defend us from the enemy.
2. It insulates. He was the pillar of fire in the wilderness at night. The enemy cannot win when the Wall of Fire overshadows. He kept them from danger. Our hedge of protection is a wall of fire. **Job 1:1**
3. It stops the enemy. God stopped the Egyptians with a wall of fire at the Red Sea. **Exodus 14:19-22**

Jesus is not only our Protector but also our Deliverer - He is the Messiah.

HE delivers and brings victory in four major areas:

- A. He gives victory over all sin. **1 John 1:7**
- B. He gives victory over the bondage of habits. **John 8:36** No more yo-yo.
- C. He gives victory over self. **Galatians 2:20** Power to conquer self-desire and self -will.
- D. He gives victory over sorrow, the problems and misfortunes we don't understand. He IS our banner even in our grief. **Psalms 121**
He is our keeper and shade.
